Understanding the Important Role of Parents at the School level in Public Education – Meeting presentation link

- PACS Supporting members
- PAC Structure that ALL public school parents/guardians are represented at the school level by their PAC, the district level by their DPAC and the provincial level by the BCCPAC.
- BCCPAC advocated for system changes, and helps parents with this. Could be as simple as writing a letter, presenting to board through appeal process...whatever they need to help
- School Act: Section 8 is about DPAC's and PAC's

- 1. Communicable Disease Plan Update
  - a. Possible Enhanced Measures from Fraser Health
