

We are thrilled to announce the arrival of a support dog that is approved by Chilliwack School District, under Policy 607, which allows for the use of canine support in the classroom. This incredible opportunity will support our students by Mrs. Moore to serve as a handler of a fully certified Pacific Assistance Dog, accredited by Assistance Dogs International.

We are proud to introduce **Gimli**, a Black Labrador Retriever who has been specially trained to work with children. From the time he was 8 weeks old until he turned two and a half, Gimli underwent extensive training to ensure he is fully prepared to support students. His training has been so thorough that he was specifically chosen for his ability to work with young people in educational environments.

While Gimli is in the school, he will wear a blue cape, which signals that he is working. We kindly ask that you and your children refrain from petting or greeting Gimli unless Mrs. Moore has given permission for him to interact. This allows Gimli to stay focused on his important role of supporting the students' social-emotional needs. Gimli is a calm and predictable dog, trained to follow commands such as "hug," "lie," "stay," and "relax." His gentle nature allows him to form kind and caring friendships with students through their shared love for animals.
