- Principal/Vice Principal's Report
  - Calendar (January - mid-February)

    - Jan 22 – Edo Japan Hot Lunch
    - Jan 23 – Assessment and Evaluation Day **(no school)**
    - Jan 30 – Movie Night
    - Feb 9 – Ready, Set, Explore for 3-5 year olds. 1-2pm
    - Feb 12 – Red, White and Pink Day
    - Feb 13 – Pro-D Day **(no school)**
    - Feb 16 – Family Day **(no school)**
    - Feb 20 – Hot Dog Hot Lunch & Term 2 ends
  - School updates & Discussion items:
    - Year-end Field Trip:
      - Cultus Lake Waterslides **June 5, 2026** for school-wide trip
      - Admin is requesting donation from PAC again this year to help subsidize the year-end trip for students; open to discussion.

- Good Medicine Songs:
  - Donation requested prior
  - Letter provided to PAC to support donation request.
- May Days (new this year):
  - Mrs. Thompson and staff are implementing this new program to McCammon this school year, as it was very successful at her previous school.
  - Similar to Kinder Fair, May Days is a longer program to aide upcoming Kindergarten children with early transition into school.
  - Given this is new and not in the original budget set out for the school year, Mrs. Thompson is requesting PAC financial support of approximately \$1,000 for program materials and take-away items for attending children.
- Staffing changes:
  - Welcome back Mrs. Navita Ohri (Education Assistant)
  - Welcome Mrs. Thompson (Principal)
- Treasurer's Report:
  - Holly presented two separate reports; regular PAC account and the Gaming account.
  - November 2025 showed lots of money coming into the school (ie. Christmas lunch donation and fundraising, and a donation from The Dogwood Monarch which should not have come to PAC but instead directly to the school.)
  - Mrs. Thompson will look into getting the Dogwood donation transferred to school account.
  - \$29,037.70 in PAC account + approximately \$700 to be deposited from MunchALunch
  - Gaming:
    - Balance of \$11,747 in the account
    - \$4,000 will be spent on Good Medicine Songs project as voted on at the September meeting
    - PAC requested an official invoice
    - Considering year-end waterslides field trip and fair as other potential areas for the balance to be used.
- DPAC Report:
  - Emily Thody absent but nothing much to report as there was no DPAC meeting in December.
  - She will report back at February's meeting as they will have met end of January.
- Fundraising Committee:
  - Family movie night upcoming on Friday, January 30
  - Snack and Freezie sales to start once weather gets warmer.
- Hot Lunch Committee:
  - Holly confirmed - \$215 raised from Edo Japan Hot Lunch
  - For a more expensive lunch option, Edo made no more or no less than other Hot Lunch options prior, so all in all was a successful first attempt
  - February will be Hot Dog Day (cooked by PAC)

- Special Committee Reports:
  - Community Day Committee:
    - Yes, PAC confirmed we'd like to host another Community Day this school year
    - Still need to form committee but PAC believes Emily Thody was maybe interested in chairing the committee (to be confirmed)
    - Potential target date – Friday, May 8, 2026 (Mrs. Thompson to confirm with staff at their next meeting)

- Grade 5 Graduation Committee:
  - Still no parents interested in chairing or being part of the Grad committee
  - Michelle advised Mrs. Thompson that PAC would assist with minor requests if needed
  - Mrs. Thompson will discuss with Teachers and advise.
